Obsahujú ošesmerovky, dopĺňovačky, úlohy na spájanie a dopisovanie.

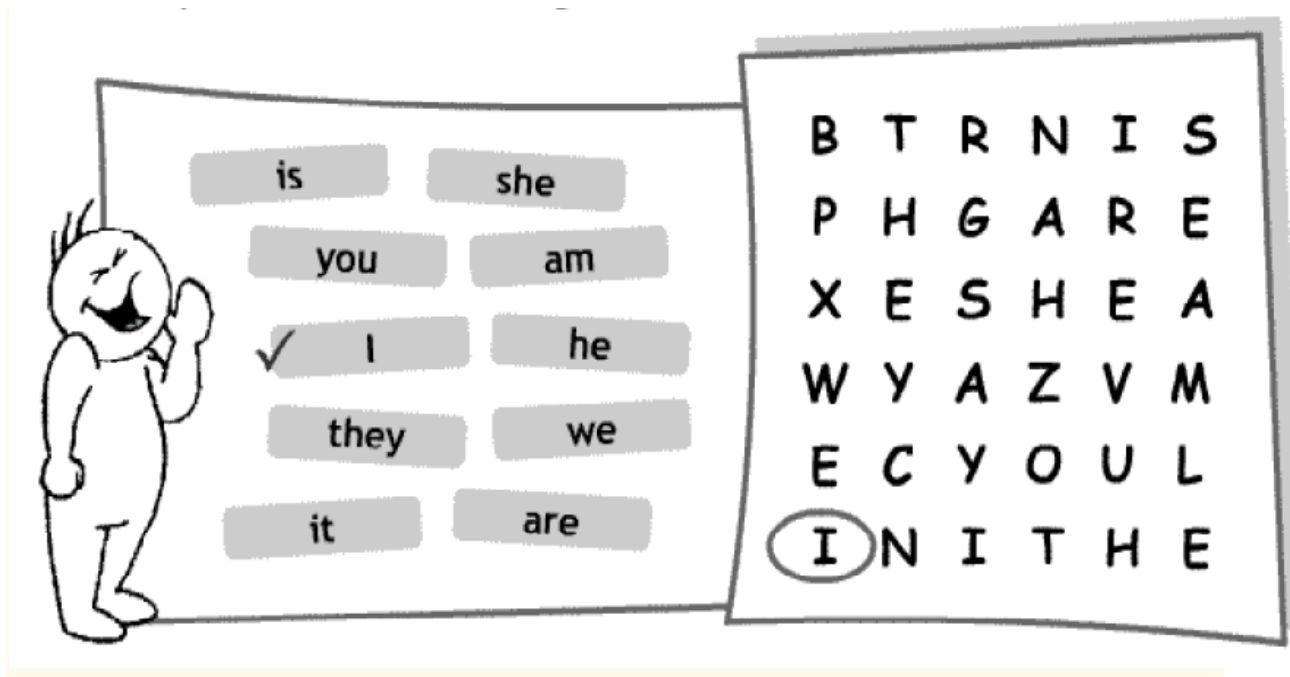
